My name is Charles McCaul. I have lived and worked in Cambodia doing NGO work since April 1995. I am now retired from directing my international organization and am living in Siem Reap City and among other things advising and doing training with Future of Khmer Children's Organization. I'm replying to an email our director, Mrs. Leng Chantheany (Theany) received from the Nightfall Organization inviting FKC to propose support of a project. I replied immediately and invited the sender to a conference call at her convenience – any morning Cambodian time.

The **Future of Khmer Children Organization** is a non-profit organization in Siem Reap, Cambodia providing supplementary education and job skills for children, youth and their families, as well as providing local community emergency relief when needed.

The organization was registered with the Cambodian government in 2009 by Mrs. Leng Chantheany. Although she had a secure job with a hotel and restaurant, Theany left her security to serve the needs of poor children and families in her Siem Reap Province.

#### Our Proposed Project: Children's Feeding Program

It is rare for Cambodians to eat a hot breakfast, especially low-income families. One problem is the income doesn't provide for it and the other problem is 80% of Cambodian families cook over wood or charcoal fires. It's not just a matter of popping something in the microwave or toaster or taking something cold out of the refrigerator, as many Cambodian families also do not have refrigerators.

Therefore, if a Cambodian child has anything for breakfast it's a piece of bread or potato chips or some other unhealthy food that is readily available and relatively inexpensive along the streets and roads. The same is true for lunch.

However, it's well-known that a nutritious breakfast and lunch are an important meals for the day.

You can sponsor nutritious meals for children at our Katsekum School. The Katsekum School serves a total of 270 children at this time in both morning and afternoon classes. Providing a nutritious meal would cost on average **USD\$1.25 per meal**. Below are options on supporting a feeding program for students.

# Two breakfasts and one lunch per week x 4 weeks:

USD\$4,050

Outcomes: Breakfast will be served to morning students and lunch will be served to afternoon students. One meal for 270 students = \$337.50. Three meals per week = \$1,012.50. Three meals per week x 4 weeks = \$4,050. Total 3,240 meals served per month.

# Two breakfasts and two lunches per week x 4 week:

USD\$5.400

Outcomes: Breakfast will be served to morning students and lunch will be served to afternoon students. One meal for 270 students = \$337.50. Four meals per week = \$1,350. Four meals per week x 4 weeks = \$5,400. Total 4,320 meals served per month.

#### Three breakfasts and three lunches per week:

USD\$8,100

Outcomes: Breakfast will be served to morning students and lunch will be served to afternoon students. One meal for 270 students = \$337.50. Six meals per week = \$2,025. Six meals per week x 4 weeks = \$8,100. Total 6,480 meals served per month.

### One-off set-up cost for cooking supplies:

USD\$939
